




### Public Expenditure in terms of Percentage of GDP




# Comparison of Cumulative Growth in Public Expenditure with Cumulative Growth in GDP




## Comparison of Cumulative Growth in Government Expenditure with Cumulative Growth in GDP









Percentage Share of Expenditure by Policy Area Group Total Government Expenditure : 2025-26 Estimate







#### Recurrent Public Expenditure by Policy Area Group




